Context:

Mine action is at a critical junction in its evolution. While Mine Action is currently facing a dramatic increase in victims and yet a downward trend in funding, its main actors are facing rapidly changing working contexts. New and protracted conflicts, urban and rural areas with mixed contamination, including improvised explosive devices, as well as challenging security situations are calling for enhanced methods of action. Combining various sets of knowledge and experience will be key to providing holistic, adequate and effective responses. In fact, the contribution of mine action organisations

to support the broader framework and goals of human security is increasingly recognised. With their unique experience and technical expertise in dealing with different forms of explosive hazards, as well as through their physical presence in complex environments, mine action organisations are well placed to partner with other actors to advance human security.
